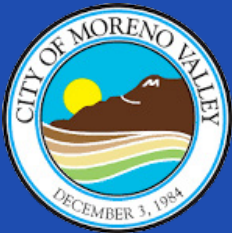


Riverside Area Rape Crisis Center dba NORA - Building Safe Communities
