for Moreno Valley Residents

### BADLANDS LANDFILL

31125 Ironwood Avenue, Moreno Valley, CA 92555

The City of Moreno Valley in partnership with the Riverside County Department of Waste Resources is providing a free dump day for Moreno Valley residents. Any commercial dumping must pay applicable fees. Residents must provide either a driver's license/California ID card or a current utility bill with City address and an ID of the resident matching name on utility bill. Loads need to be covered/secured per Landfill Rules.

#### ACCEPTED:

**BULKY ITEMS** – Outdoor/indoor furniture

**APPLIANCES** – Limited to two (2) per customer per day. (Includes washers/dryers/refrigerators/freezers, water coolers, stoves, ovens, air conditioners microwaves).

**MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS** – Limited to two (2) Mattresses/Box Springs per customer per day. Box Springs are included in the limits.

**UNIVERSAL WASTE** - Electronic Waste/TVs/Computers, Fluorescent Bulbs/Tubes, Mercury Containing Devices, Smoke Detectors.

**COMBINED WASTE LISTED BELOW** cannot exceed 15 gallons by volume or 125 pounds per trip. Containers cannot exceed 5 gallons or weigh more than 50 pounds. (Antifreeze, Household & Auto Batteries, Latex and Oil-Based Paint, Cooking Oil, Aerosols, Used Oil and Filters)

#### NOT ACCEPTED:

**TIRES**

**HAZARDOUS WASTE**

**ASBESTOS**

**COMPRESSED GAS CYLINDERS**

**PESTICIDES**

**CLEANERS**

**GARDEN CHEMICALS**

**POOL CHLORINE**

**ANY OTHER TYPES OF CHEMICALS NOT LISTED IN THE ACCEPTABLE SECTION**

#### LANDFILL RULES:

- A.1 Landfill rules must be always followed. RCDWR is committed to developing positive relationships with its customers and providing a safe environment. Violations of the landfill rules may result in permanent restriction from Department facilities. The landfill rules at the Badlands Landfill are as follows:
- 1.1 All loads must be covered/secured or will be subject to a \$25 fee.
  - 1.2 Obey County personnel and signs. It is for your safety.
  - 1.3 Anyone under 16 years of age and pets must remain in vehicle.
  - 1.4 High visibility safety vests must be worn at all times.
  - 1.5 Stay within 5 feet of your vehicle while unloading and 15 feet away from heavy equipment.
  - 1.6 No alcohol, drugs, weapons, smoking, salvaging, or loitering.
  - 1.7 CITY residents who use vehicles with Commercial logos will not be able to use the landfill facility at no cost.
- A.2 County is not responsible for damage to customer's vehicle and/or equipment due to customer's negligence or failure to follow site rules, and reserves the right to deny access to anyone violating said rules or creating a safety hazard. Landfills are dangerous construction zones. Disposal is at customer's own risk.
- A.3 All loads are subject to inspection. Disposal of hazardous, toxic, flammable, corrosive, explosive and radioactive waste/materials may be prosecuted under California Health and Safety Code 25189.5 and Penal Code 374.8.
- A.4 Admission is first come first served. There is a limit of 612 vehicles per day. Landfill customers will be turned away once that limit is met.
