



- The City of Moreno Valley has grown steadily in 2021. From 2011 to 2021, employment has grown rapidly, increasing by 29,741 jobs to reach 55,819. The Transportation, Warehousing, and Utilities sector represented nearly two-thirds of all new jobs created between 2011 and 2021.
- Employment in the City of Moreno Valley grew 11.0%, or 5,768 jobs, from the fourth quarter of 2020 to the fourth quarter of 2021. This outpaces the 6.6% growth in the Balance of Riverside County over the same period.
- Administrative Support; Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services and Management; Information, Other Services, and Education were the City's fastest growing sectors, in terms of employment, from the fourth quarter of 2020 to the fourth quarter of 2021.
- Wages in the City of Moreno Valley grew 3.0% from the fourth quarter of 2020 to the fourth quarter of 2021.
- At the sector level, wage growth was strongest in Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services and Management; Education; Leisure and Hospitality; Natural Resources and Construction; and Retail Trade from the fourth quarter of 2020 to the fourth quarter of 2021.
- Over the most recent year for which data is available (2021), employment growth was strongest in establishments employing more than 200 workers.
