ELC members must:

- Be between 14 and 20 years old;
- Be enrolled in an educational institution;
- Serve a minimum two-year term;
- Attend monthly meetings;
- Recruit two youth members before the end of their term

- ELC Council members will receive a \$25 stipend for every monthly meeting attended
- College-aged youth enrolled in Moreno Valley College will receive special consideration for the Mayor's Challenge MoVal Learns stipend
