MoVan Highlights

📀 Eligibility

Moreno Valley resident who is age 60 years of age or more, or an adult who is physically disabled who does not require assistance. For riders who need assistance, your are required to travel with an escort.

芝 Curb-to-Curb Services

Passenger is picked up and dropped off at the curb or driveway of their origin and destination.

📀 Our Van

Our clean van has air conditioning, a well trained and safe operator; and observes the manufacturer maintenance schedule. Our 14 passenger bus includes wheelchair capacity for 2.

\$1.00 for one-way trips\$2.50 for one-way trips outside of the city limits (Medical visits only)

TITLE VI NOTICE TO PUBLIC: Your Rights Under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 requires that no person in the United States, on the grounds of race, color or national origin be excluded from, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination, under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

FMVSCI's responsibilities is to inform the public of its obligations through public notices which details FMVSCI's Title VI complaint procedures. Any person who believes they have been denied access to or while using the MoVan transit service due to their race, age or national origin may file a written complaint. All complaints will be fairly and objectively investigated.
